## **Driving Tests and Mechanic Trade Test from 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2023**

In the ongoing recruitment process of 2022, as per Para 19 A (iii) of the Recruitment Notification in Rc No. 39 / Rect / Admn-1 / 2022 date 25<sup>th</sup> April 2022, Candidates of SCT Police Constable (Mechanics) (Men) in PTO who qualified in the Physical Efficiency Test will be required to appear and qualify in a Trade Test as per the designated procedure. As per Para 19 A (iv) of the above said Recruitment Notification, Candidates of SCT Police Constable (Drivers) (Men) in PTO who qualified in the Physical Efficiency Test will be required to appear and qualify in a Driving Test as per the designated procedure. Similarly, as per Para 17 A (iv) of Recruitment Notification in Rc No. 60 / Rect. / Admn-1 / 2022, dated 20<sup>th</sup> May 2022, Candidates of Driver Operator in Telangana State Disaster Response & Fire Services Department who qualified in the Physical Efficiency Test will be required to appear and qualify in a Driving Test as per the designated procedure. The Driving Tests / Mechanic Trade Test will be conducted at SAR CPL Amberpet Grounds, Hyderabad from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> March 2023.

# Admit Cards Downloadable from 25th to 28th February 2023

All the Candidates who have qualified for Driving Tests / Mechanic Trade Test are informed that their individual Admit Cards can be downloaded from 8 a m on 25<sup>th</sup> February onwards till 12 midnight on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2023 by logging into their respective user accounts on the TSLPRB website: www.tslprb.in by entering their credentials. Candidates whose Admit Cards could not be downloaded may send e-mail to support@tslprb.in or contact us on 93937 11110 or 93910 05006.

After downloading the Admit Card, Candidates shall take a printout of the same, preferably on A4 size paper. Admit Card has 2 parts:

- ➤ The top portion having details of Date and Venue, Candidate Particulars and details of List of Documents to be submitted at the Venue of Driving Test / Mechanic Trade Test must be preserved till the final conclusion of the process of Recruitment.
- ➤ The bottom portion of the Admit Card is a Check Slip which will be taken away by the Representative Officer of the TSLPRB (along with Self Attested Photocopies of the Relevant Certificates submitted by each Candidate) at the time of allowing the Candidate to register for Driving Test / Mechanic Trade Test on the date of the Test.

### **Documents / Self-Attested Photocopies to be Submitted**

Candidates shall bring the following documents (whichever are relevant) along with Admit Card to the Venue of Driving Tests / Mechanic Trade Test without fail, as these are essentially required for their registration for the Test –

- 1. Print-Out of PMT / PET Performance Sheet duly Signed by the Candidate
- 2. Original Driving Licence of Light Motor Vehicle (Transport) or Heavy Motor Vehicle Licence (for SCT PC Driver Post only)
- 3. Original Heavy Motor Vehicle Licence (for Driver Operator Post only)
- 4. Self-Attested Photocopy of Driving Licence (for Drivers Posts only)
- 5. Self-Attested Copy of Driving Licence Information (Grant of issue of Driving Licence) issued by Licensing Authority (for Drivers Posts only)
- 6. Self-Attested Photocopy of ITI Certificate in Wiremen <u>OR</u> Mechanic Motor Vehicle OR Mechanic Diesel <u>OR</u> Fitter (as on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2022) <u>OR</u> Higher Qualification than the prescribed one (as on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2022) (for SCT PC Mechanic Post only)

### **Important Instructions to the Candidates**

Candidates are advised to visit their Venue of Driving Test / Mechanic Trade Test one day prior to the actual Date of Test and make sure about the Venue. No traveling expenses will be paid for the journey, if any, performed to take the Test. Candidates are advised to be punctual in reporting at the Venue at the Time and on the Date given in their Admit Card. If any Candidate fails to do so, it will be presumed that he is not interested in participating in further process of recruitment and his candidature will automatically lapse.

Candidates are advised not to bring any unnecessary personal belongings to the Venue as such material may become a hindrance to their effective participation in the Driving Test(s) / Mechanic Trade Test. Candidates are advised not to come for the examination carrying handbags / jholas / pouches etc. No Cloak Room / Storage Facility to safeguard any valuables or belongings of the Candidates is available at the Examination Centre. No Mobile Phones are allowed into the Ground.

There will be verification of identity of each Candidate based on the Biometric Data available with TSLPRB before permitting them to undergo the Driving Test(s) / Mechanic Trade Test. Therefore, Candidates are advised not to have mehendi, temporary tattoos or any obstructive material-covers on their fingers which may hamper the verification of Biometrics. Adoption of any kind of unfair means or any act of impersonation during the Driving Test(s) / Mechanic Trade Test will render the Candidate liable for invalidation of his candidature as well as appropriate criminal action.

Candidates will be subjected to digital surveillance while attending Driving Test(s) / Trade Test and <u>Digital RFID Wristbands</u> will be attached to each Candidate soon after the <u>completion of the Biometric Verification</u>. The Wristband shall not be tampered with during the process of Tests throughout the stay of the Candidate on the Ground. Wristband will be removed by an Authorized Officer only after the conclusion of the Test(s). Any tampering or tearing or disturbance of the Wristband will make the Candidate liable for Disqualification.

Candidates are advised to visit their Centre of Examination one day prior to the actual Date of Examination and make sure about their Examination Centre. No traveling expenses will be paid for the journey, if any performed, to take the Test. Adoption of any kind of unfair means or any act of impersonation during the Examination will render the Candidate liable for invalidation of his / her candidature as well as criminal action. The top portion of the Admit Card must be preserved till the final conclusion of the process of Recruitment.
